**CORRECTIONAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION - WISCONSIN:** Founded in 1984, CEA is a non-profit, professional education association. Correction education sites in Wisconsin include jails, juvenile and adult state institutions and a federal prison.

Opening in 1984, in Green Bay, outpatient programs serve both adults and adolescents at the Green Bay facility as well a satellite offices in Marinette and Sheboygan.

**DCF/DFES/BWF/PARTNER TRAINING SECTION:** Serves as a vital link between policy development and program implementation, training thousands of Wisconsin Economic Support and /employment and Training professionals, to implement progressive programs leading to higher levels of self sufficiency and a better prepared workforce.

**RAWHIDE:** Since 1965, Rawhide has helped troubled teen-aged boys change their lives by providing residential care and counseling. It is a faith-based, non-profit organization, offering a unique blend of academic, work experience and moral training to help them become productive members of the community.

**WISCONSIN CHALLENGE ACADEMY:** (Fort McCoy, WI) It is a voluntary residential program for at-risk Wisconsin teens and is committed to improving the quality of life for all ages 16 years 9 months and they must not turn 19 years within the first two weeks of the program.

**WISCONSIN COUNCIL ON PROBLEM GAMBLING:** (Green Bay) Provides resources, public awareness and education in problem and pathological gambling disorders while maintaining strict neutrality on the issue of legalized gambling. Treatment provides referrals crisis center information, in-patient centers and many other community resources and offers self-help information.
